#### 3. Guideline to Ship

This is a step by step guide how to ship parts to this location.

## **Packing requirements**

• All wood products made from raw wood will be subject to wood packaging regulations in most countries. Exemptions will be manufactured wood (i.e.: plywood, fibreboard, etc. provided they are not supported by raw wooden products).

## **DG Cargo:**

The IATA rules and regulations concerning dangerous goods apply. The shipper must prepare all DG in accordance with the latest regulations. This includes: packaging, labeling, licencing and documentation.

## **Shipping documentation required:**

- 1 original invoice inside the box and one copy on the outside of the box
- Current or last valid airworthiness certification copy outside the box
- CE declaration/certificate 1 copy per part if required
- Fumigation certificate required if no ISPM markings present (if wood package)
- DG Declaration (if required)

## 4. Invoice Details

All invoices and packing list should display the following compliance elements:

- Shipped by air, CIP Airport Destination (Amsterdam/AMS) (Incoterms 2020)
- Shipped by courier, DAP Airport Destination (Oude Meer/AMS) (Incoterms 2020)
- Value stated for customs purposes only,
- Country of Origin,
- Currency
- HS Code
- Export Control Classification Number (ECCN)
- State on invoice if parts are serviceable or unserviceable
- Current or last valid airworthiness certificate number (FAA/EASA/TCCA etc.)

**<u>Note:</u>** The following statements should be noted on every Invoice for customs' clearance purposes:

• If part is a PBH covered component, invoice should state – "PBH core return".
